Our Success

RWBA would like to congratulate all of our students in the Sixth Form for working incredibly hard and achieving such excellent results that students, staff and parents should be very proud of.

This year A level results were outstanding with 25% achieving A*-A grade and 74% achieving A*-C grade. 100% achieved a Level 3 Qualification.

At Royal Wootton Bassett Academy Sixth Form our students progress on to several different pathways with advice being given to facilitate this throughout the two years. Many students choose university whether it be Oxbridge, Russell Group or one of the many superb universities offering specialist courses. Others choose to go into employment via the degree apprenticeship route or directly into the workplace.

This year saw **99** students head off to university, one student successfully gained a place at Oxford to study History. 2 students went to study Medicine, 4 students have started degree apprenticeships in firms such as Airbus, BAE systems and Leonardo. Most students gained their first place at university be it, Oxford, Exeter, Leeds, Manchester, Sheffield, Cardiff, Birmingham, Durham or Southampton to name just a few.

Pathways

We support students wishing to access different pathways for their future careers: Oxbridge, Medics, Vets & Dentists.

Royal Wootton Bassett Academy has a fantastic record of supporting students with their applications to Oxford and Cambridge University. Students having excelled at GCSE gaining the majority of 8/9s and predicted grades at A level of AAA* have the potential to apply to Oxbridge.

Support is provided for students applying for the highly competitive Medics, Vets and Dental courses, they are encouraged to gain a wide range of work experience over their time in the Sixth Form and seek out support via opportunities such as the Dare to Doctor Scheme.

Pastoral Care

We have an experienced team who work extensively with Sixth Form Students.

The team consists of Head of Sixth Form, Deputy Head of Sixth Form, Head of Year, Pastoral Manager and Sixth Form administrator along with our Tutor team that act as Academic and Pastoral Tutors.

This core team works along side our Careers Advisor, School Counsellor and School Nurse.

If students have concerns relating to their studies, family or personal life we are happy to assist in whatever way we can.

We encourage independence but are happy to put in place strategies to guide students through exam periods and help foster a healthy balance of work and play when the going gets tough.
